A duly noticed Public Hearing was held in the board room at Saltillo City Hall on Tuesday, April 16, 2019 at 5:30 P.M. to discuss a variance request by CWM Properties, LLC for re-zoning 5 acres, parcel 053V-06-013-00, located at 647 Pulltight Rd.

Present for the hearing were Terry Glidewell, Craig Sanders, Malcomb Driskill, Copey Grantham, City Clerk Mary Parker, City Attorney Chris Evans, Brian Grissom, Whitney McNutt, Grant Bailey, Tammy Reynolds, and Mark Nowell. Mayor Smith recused himself from this public hearing and all discussion relate thereto.

Brian Grissom was sworn in as was Whitney McNutt. Mrs. McNutt is asking for a re-zoning on the property from R-1 Estate Residential District to R-3 Medium Density Residential District.
