The Mayor opened with the pledge of allegiance and Alderman Craig Sanders led with a prayer.

Thereupon the Mayor declared a legal quorum present and the meeting was opened for the following business:

RE: JAWS OF LIFE GRANT

On the motion of Copey Grantham, seconded by Scottie Clark, and by an affirmative vote of all present to accept and approve the JAWS of Life Grant as presented by Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation in the amount of Thirty three thousand one hundred and eighty dollars (\$33,180.00). This will be a 100% grant for a new set of emergency tools for the fire department.

RE: DILAPEDATED HOUSES

The Mayor informed the board he had received several phone calls from various people asking if Park and Rec would form a volleyball league for players 2nd to 6th grade. The board thought this was a good idea and told the mayor to ask Justin Clark, interim director, to begin looking into park and rec volleyball. No action taken.

RE: BUDGET CUT RECOMMENDATIONS

On the motion of Craig Sanders, seconded by Donald Cullum, and by an affirmative vote of all present to 1) stop all over-time and part-time employment for all city employees unless first approved by the Mayor; 2) department heads are to purchase only what is necessary for day-to-day operations of the department; no city sponsored travel or training without express permission of the Mayor or Board, all due to the economic effects the COVID-19 pandemic is having on the city's budget. The clerk also informed the board that the general fund was seeing a reduction in court fines, as well as a \$13,000.00 deficit due to the forgiveness of the debt of the fire department for the air packs as previously approved by the board prior to the pandemic.
