A duly noticed Public Hearing was held in the board room at Saltillo City Hall on Tuesday, August 6, 2019 at 5:30 P.M. to discuss the request by Krystal Restaurant for a sign variance at 1181 Turner Park Rd.

Present for the hearing were Mayor Rex Smith, Terry Glidewell, Craig Sanders, Donald Cullum, City Clerk Mary Parker, City Attorney Chris Evans, Brian Grissom and Gerald McKary.

Grissom informed the board that McKary wanted to make sure the sign could be seen from Highway 45 and was asking for a variance to have a sign 25' high single pole x 7.1 x 15'5" double sided plus a reader board measuring 4'2" x 8'1".
