MINUTES OF THE PROCEEDING OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMAN OF THE CITY OF SALTILLO, MISSISSIPPI WHO MET IN A DULY NOTICED SPECIAL BOARD MEETING HELD ON WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 30, 2020 AT THE CITY HALL BOARD ROOM AT 12:00 P.M.

Be it remembered that the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Saltillo, Mississippi met in a duly noticed special board meeting held on Wednesday, December 30, 2020 at the City Hall Board Room at 12:00 p.m. and the following officials were present to wit:

Mayor Rex Smith opened with the pledge of allegiance and led in prayer.

Thereupon the Mayor declared a legal quorum present and the meeting was opened for the following business:

RE: PERSONNEL

On the motion of Scottie Clark, and by an affirmative vote of all present to discuss whether a personnel issue in the police department qualifies for executive session.

On the motion of Scottie Clark, seconded by Craig Sanders, and by an affirmative vote of all present to go into executive session in order to discuss a police department personnel matter.

Present in executive session were Mayor Rex Smith, Aldermen Clark, Sanders, and Glidewell, , police chief Grant Bailey, assistant police chief Chris Joshlin, city attorney Chris Evans and Deputy City Clerk Monica Daniels.. A police department personnel issue was discussed.

On the motion of Scottie Clark, seconded by Terry Glidewell and by an affirmative vote of all present to go out of executive session and back into regular session.

On the motion of Scottie Clark, seconded by Terry Glidewell, and by an affirmative vote of all present to approve the FMLA continuation request of police officer Dylan Whitt. In passing this motion, the board has determined that Officer Whitt has approximately two (2) weeks of FMLA leave remaining from his original maximum twelve (12) weeks of FMLA leave, including the use of approximately ten (10) weeks of such leave beginning in September of 2020. Any time off work in addition to the approximate two (2) weeks mentioned above will be without benefits. If officer Whitt has not returned to work prior to January 31, 2021, then he will be responsible for paying his own health insurance premium. If he pays his own health insurance premium for January 31, 2021 and then returns to work thereafter, then the city will consider a pro-rata refund of such paid premium based upon the amount of time actually worked during the month of February. Officer Whitt's position with the police department will be kept open during his remaining time on FMLA. These findings will be sent to the employee via email and a copy of same will be placed in his personnel file, as opposed to an attachment to these minutes.


