A duly noticed Public Hearing was held in the board room at Saltillo City Hall on Tuesday, February 19, 2019 at 5:00 P.M. to discuss a variance request by Bobby Smith for lot 5 Bostic Place, located at the corner of Bostic Ave. and Graham Court.

Present for the hearing were Terry Glidewell, Craig Sanders, Donald Cullum, City Clerk Mary Parker, City Attorney Chris Evans, Bobby Smith, Brian Grissom, Dinky Crowder, Ray Massengill, Grant Bailey, David Jones, Tommy Hood, and Ryan Flippen. Mayor Smith recused himself from this public hearing and all discussion relate thereto.

Brian Grissom was sworn in as was Bobby Smith. Mr. Smith is asking for a variance on his property at the corner of Bostic and Graham that would allow the minimum lot width to be reduced from 60 feet to 52 feet in an MX Mixed Use neighborhood district.
