A duly noticed Public Hearing was held in the board room at Saltillo City Hall on Tuesday, January 16, 2018 at 5:30 P.M. to hear from the Mayor and City Attorney Chris Evans concerning the establishment of a Redevelopment Plan.

Present for the hearing were Donald Cullum, Terry Glidewell, Copey Grantham, Craig Sanders, Malcomb Driskill, Zoning Administrator Brian Grissom, City Clerk Mary Parker, City Attorney Chris Evans, Fire Chief Mark Nowell, Assistant Fire Chief Chris Jenkins, volunteers Jon Sprinkle and Austin Hill and Bill Monogan.

Mayor Smith turned the discussion over to City Attorney Chris Evans. Evans explained to the board the reasons necessary to establish and enter into a city-wide Redevelopment Plan. The plan would include the entire city limit and would serve as a the first step in potentially entering a TIF at a later date. The entry of this plan does not cost the city any money and does not bind or obligate the board to any action, but would serve to show any potential commercial developers that the board is eager to listen to any proposal and to potentially cooperate with them in the location of new business within the city.

Mayor Smith asked if there was anyone else to be heard and hearing none he moved into the special called meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen.
