A duly noticed Public Hearing was held in the board room at Saltillo City Hall on Tuesday, July 16, 2019 at 5:30 P.M. to discuss the request by Joe Young and Merrill Johnston from that of R-2 Low Density Residential to R-3 Medium Density Residential.
