#### RE: BOBBY WILLIAMS SPECIAL EXCEPTION REQUEST

On the motion of Copey Grantham, seconded by Terry Glidewell, and by an affirmative vote of Terry Glidewell, Copey Grantham, and Craig Sanders, with Scottie Clark not voting, to deny the special exception request of Bobby Williams to place a storage building on his real property located on Second Street. A duly noticed public hearing was held on April 6, 2021 to hear this request, to which some objections to the request were mentioned. In making this finding, the Board finds that the requests does not meet the requirements of the zoning ordinance and would otherwise not be appropriate or in the best interest of the downtown area under the circumstances.
