They are wanting to allow customers to bring in their own wine and liquor. A6 would provide the cups and ice but would not be serving the drinks. They also would provide an employee whose responsibility would be to watch to make sure that no one underage is drinking and when they leave that all alcohol products would be closed and sealed. The days and times of the business would stay the same. They are asking that we would give this request to them temporality until their present lease would run out in July, 2021.
