Mayor Rex Smith opened with the pledge of allegiance and Steve Yeomen led with a prayer.

A duly noticed Public Hearing was held in the board room at Saltillo City Hall on Tuesday, March 24, 2020 at 5:30 P.M. to hear the request for rezoning of property on Dogwood and Kellum.

Present for the hearing were Mayor Rex Smith, Terry Glidewell, Craig Sanders, Donald Cullum, Copey Grantham, City Clerk Mary Parker, City Attorney Chris Evans, Brian Grissom, and Steve Yeoman

Brian Grissom and Steve Yeoman were placed under oath. Mr. Yeoman came before the Mayor and Board to ask for his property at 108 Kellum, parcel 054L-20-025-01, to be re-zoned from R-2 to MX. He is planning on dividing the property into three (3) lots and building three (3) houses approximately 1300 square feet each. It was discussed that the set-backs would need to be far enough from the roadway to allow for sufficient driveway parking and that a reasonable turn around would be made at the end of the main drive if sufficient space is available.
