**MINUTES OF THE PROCEEDING OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMAN OF THE CITY OF SALTILLO, MISSISSIPPI WHO MET IN A DULY NOTICED SPECIAL BOARD MEETING HELD ON MONDAY, NOVEMBER 19, 2018 AT THE CITY HALL BOARD ROOM AT 6:00 PM**

Be it remembered that the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Saltillo, Mississippi met in a duly noticed special board meeting held on Monday, November 19, 2018 at the City Hall Board Room at 12:00 p.m. and the following officials were present to wit:

Mayor Smith led with the pledge of allegiance and Alderman Terry Glidewell led with a prayer.

Thereupon the Mayor declared a legal quorum present and the meeting was opened for the following business:

**RE: APPROVE AGENDA ITEMS**

On the motion Copey Grantham, seconded by Donald Cullum, and by an affirmative vote of all present to approve the agenda items.

**RE: WATER DISCUSSION**

Water Operator Mike Jackson came before the board to give an update on the water system. Jackson informed the board that in the spring of 2010 a 12" water line had been laid from Water Street to the corner of Third and Mobile (B-Quick). Also, a 12" line had been ran from the box company to the corner at B-Quick. He said they have connected 125 customers but that 29 customers still needed to be connected to the pipe. There is a lot of old pipes still in the ground that need to be replaced on the east side of town. The estimated cost to finish connecting 145, Meg's Lane and Ivywood would be \$10,320.00. Jackson also informed the board that the city needed to conduct tests of the city's existing pumps. The approximate cost on the test is \$30,000. Jackson just wanted to make sure the mayor and board were aware of issues that needed to be addressed.

**RE: SEWER DISCUSSION**

Mayor Smith informed the board that the City of Guntown has 196 proposed lots that will be under construction in the near future and would be needing to add these to the Saltillo sewer treatment plant. There is also a proposed subdivision that is going to be under construction in the Saltillo area that will serve potentially 450 homes. It is time for Saltillo, Guntown, and Baldwin to have some serious discussions about sewer. Mayor Smith will sit down with Guntown Mayor Herring in the next couple of days.
