A duly noticed Public Hearing was held in the board room at Saltillo City Hall on Tuesday, November 3, 2020 at 5:30 P.M. to a special exception to change, expand or alter a nonconforming use (mobile home) for the property located at 257 Fellowship Road, parcel # 055U-21-061-00.

Present for the hearing were Mayor Rex Smith, Terry Glidewell, Craig Sanders, Scottie Clark , City Clerk Mary Parker, City Attorney Chris Evans, Brian Grissom, William Moore, Arthur DeVaughn and George DeVaughn.

Mr. DeVaughn is asking for a special exception to change, alter or expand a non-conforming use so that he may replace an old mobile home on the property with a new mobile home (68' x 28') . The mobile home will have a standard pitch roof, 220 wiring and brick underpinning. The said home will be placed upon a large tract of acreage and will therefore not encroach on or inhibit any adjoining owner. No one appeared at the meeting to question or object to the requested relief.
